We can confirm that Pope Plant Ltd was recently instructed to conduct bulk earthworks at a former chalk quarry in the Medway area. In preparation for the importation of inert materials under an Environmental Permit, this work involved site clearance and the construction of an access ramp.

The project was not straightforward as it called for careful compliance with a technical engineering specification and the undertaking of a co-ordinated laboratory testing regime. Approximately 37,000 m³ of site-derived materials were excavated from the quarry basin, before being hauled, placed and compacted to form the access ramp. Pope Plant also co-ordinated the importation and placement of some 3,500 tonnes of crushed concrete to complete the ramp.

The project team was led by Craig Pope, who was able to deliver the works professionally, on time and in a cost efficient manner. His hands on approach and clear understanding of the technical challenges meant that he was able to liaise effectively with us and to work competently to any directions he was given.
